The Old Orchard Neighborhoods Association is excited to welcome the return of the neighborhood Garden Tour to be held on Sunday, June 11, 2023 from 10 AM - 5 PM. The tour will feature eight unique gardens exhibiting different design styles, plant selections, and beautiful outdoor spaces.

As one of the city's unique and historic neighborhoods, Old Orchard continues to be a haven for trees and gardens since its transformation from apple and pear orchards in the 1920s. The neighborhood features many unique homes and an abundance of large, old-growth trees creating a beautiful tree canopy. "The tour is a very popular event for garden enthusiasts," said Brent Lohmann, committee organizer. "Nearly 600 people attended last year's tour. We look forward to sharing a unique selection of beautiful garden spaces and guests will be amazed by the hidden gems behind Old Orchard homes," he added.

Event tickets are \$10 per person and can be purchased starting May 1 at [oldorchardgardens.org](http://oldorchardgardens.org) or at Bartz Viviano Flowers (Secor Road, Oregon and Waterville locations). Tickets may also be purchased the day of the tour at SIP Coffee (3160 Markway Road) and at the ticket tent at Darlington and Barrington. Proceeds from the tour will fund beautification initiatives of the Old Orchard Neighborhoods Association. This outdoor event is self-guided and easy for attendees to social distance as needed to provide a safe experience. The event is held rain or shine.
