Old Orchard Garden Tour Returns Sunday, June 8, 2025

TOLEDO, OH — The Old Orchard Neighborhoods Association (OONA) is thrilled to announce the highly anticipated return of the Old Orchard Garden Tour, taking place on Sunday, June 8, 2025, from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM. This year's self-guided tour will showcase six unique gardens, each offering distinct design styles, vibrant plant selections, and beautifully crafted outdoor spaces.

Nestled in one of the city's most historic and charming neighborhoods, Old Orchard has long been celebrated for its rich natural beauty and historic homes. Originally transformed from apple and pear orchards in the 1920s, the neighborhood is known for its impressive tree canopy and timeless gardens.

"We're excited to invite the community to explore the hidden gems tucked behind Old Orchard homes," said Brent Lohmann, committee organizer. "The growing interest in gardening has been amazing—last year, we welcomed nearly 800 attendees, and we look forward to an even greater turnout this year."

Tickets for the event are priced at \$10 per person and will be available for purchase starting May 1 at oldorchardgardens.org. On the day of the event, tickets can also be purchased at SIP Coffee (3160 Markway Road) and a ticket tent at the intersection of Darlington and Barrington.

Proceeds from the tour will support OONA's neighborhood beautification initiatives. Garden hosts will be on hand throughout the event to answer questions, and the tour will be held rain or shine.
